"DECEIVING AND BEING DECEIVED"

"Evil men and impostors will grow worse and worse, deceiving and being deceived" (2nd Timothy 3:13). According to the apostle Paul, it is evil to be either a deceiver or to be one who is deceived.

It should be obvious that anyone who leads others into error stands to be blamed, as Peter warned, "There will be false teachers among you, who will secretly bring in destructive heresies, even denying the Lord who bought them, and bring on themselves swift destruction" (2nd Peter 2:1). Faithful Christians must take decisive action in shunning those who promote falsehood, as Paul urged, "Note those who cause divisions and offenses, contrary to the doctrine which you learned, and avoid them. For those who are such do not serve our Lord Jesus Christ, but their own belly, and by smooth words and flattering speech deceive the hearts of the simple" (Romans 16:17-18).

It is perhaps less obvious that, not only the deceivers, but also those who have accepted and obeyed their doctrines are guilty, as well. Paul asserted that it is "evil" to be "deceived" and that fact must not be overlooked.

Remember that "the serpent deceived Eve by his craftiness" (2nd Corinthians 11:3), and also that "the woman being deceived, fell into transgression" (1st Timothy 2:14). Jehovah cursed them both: the deceiver and the deceived (Genesis 3:14-16).

Scripture repeatedly commands, "Do not be deceived" (1st Corinthians 6:9; 15:33; Galatians 6:7; James 1:16). It is, therefore, incumbent upon every soul to investigate each doctrine in the light of God's word to ascertain truth and reject falsehood.

Believing deception, one disbelieves truth and "unbelief" faces severe and eternal consequences (Romans 11:20; Hebrews 3:12, 19).

MARRIAGE IS BESIDE THE POINT

Jorge Mario Bergoglio, known to Catholics as their "Pope Francis," declared on Monday that priests are now permitted to "bless" homosexual unions, although they are forbidden from officiating any same-sex marriages. Furthermore, homosexuality is included as one variety of "fornication" or "sexual immorality" every time those terms appear, which happens to be dozens in the New Testament.

There would be no point in the Holy Spirit chastising same-sex marriages if homosexuality itself is already expressly and indirectly verboten, which it is.

The papacy is playing pointless games in this latest announcement and nothing about it honors God in the least.
