ANGELS

IV. THEIR FUNCTION

A. Psalm 103:20-22

The purpose of angels is to do whatever God tells them to do.

B. Psalm 78:49

On many occasions, angels were the agents of God's wrath, used to kill men.

1. Acts 12:23

King Herod was struck by an angel, leading to his gruesome death.

2. 2nd Kings 19:35

An angel once slew 185,000 Assyrians in a single night.

C. 1st Timothy 3:16; John 1:51

During Jesus' time on earth, angels were actively attending Him.

1. Luke 2:8-14

Angels announced His birth to the shepherds.

2. Mark 1:13

Angels ministered to Him during His ordeal in the wilderness.

3. Luke 22:41-43

An angel strengthened Him as He prayed for the cup to pass.

D. Luke 4:10-12; Matthew 26:51-54

However, Jesus declined to rely on angels when doing so would counteract His purpose, either yielding to temptation as the devil wanted or avoiding the suffering of the cross.

E. Acts 7:52-53; Galatians 3:19

Angels presented the Old Testament. This is in keeping with the literal meaning of the word angel, which is "messenger".

1. Hebrews 2:2-3

In contrast, Christ and the apostles presented the New. This makes the New better than the Old.

2. Galatians 1:8

No angel could now present revelation without sinfully contradicting the truth.

F. Hebrews 1:13-14; Psalm 34:7

Angels serve God's people.

1. Daniel 3:19-28

An angel protected Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed-Nego in the fiery furnace.

2. Daniel 6:16-22

An angel protected Daniel in the den of lions.

3. Acts 5:19-20

An angel sprang the apostles out of prison.

4. Acts 12:7-11

An angel sprang Peter from prison.

5. Acts 27:23-24

An angel comforted Paul when he was approaching shipwreck.

Whether this function of theirs ceased with the cessation of spiritual gifts (1st Corinthians 13) is uncertain. If they continue in this capacity, it is not in a visible manner. To ascribe activities to them or deny activities to them would be unfounded. We do not know.

G. Luke 16:22

Angels carry the righteous dead to their reward.

H. Matthew 25:31-33

Angels will be present for the final judgment.

1. 1st Thessalonians 4:16

An archangel's shout will herald the dawn of the last great day.

2. Luke 12:8-9

Angels will witness either Christ's confession or His denial of those who either confessed Him or denied Him.

3. 2nd Thessalonians 1:7-10

Angels will be involved in executing vengeance on the unbelieving and disobedient.

4. Matthew 13:49-50

They will haul the wicked to their ultimate doom.
